SECTION 4: First-Aid Measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

Special protective equipment:

SECTION 6: Accidental Release Measures

6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

6.3. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

For small amounts: Pick up with suitable absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, general-purpose binder, kieselguhr).

For large amounts: Dike spillage. Pump off product.

Wear suitable protective equipment. Dispose of absorbed material in accordance with regulations. Collect waste in suitable containers, which can be labeled and sealed. Clean contaminated floors and objects thoroughly with water and detergents, observing environmental regulations.

SECTION 7: Handling and Storage

7.1. Precautions for safe handling
